## Ellen Kuras ASC

Oscar nominated cinematographer (Eternal sunshine of the spotless mind) Ellen is also an Oscar nominated documentary director (The betrayal).

## Roger Pratt BSC

Oscar nominated cinematographer, (DP on amongst other Chokolat, Harry Potter, Troy, The fisher king, latest "The Karate kid" (Dir Harald Zwart)

## Barry Ackroyd BSC

Oscar nominated cinematographers (Amongst others. the Oskar winning "The hurt locker"), and is working for directors like. Ken Loach, Ralph Fiennes and Paul Greengrass.

## Jan Troell

Director and cinematographer. Twice Oscar nominated. Last film "Maria Larsson's everlasting moments". Jan Troell often photographs parts of his feature films. We will talk to him about his role as a director, being also a cinematographer, and how this influences his visual approach.
